#### \*\*\*GPA NOTICE\*\*\*

Your child has a cumulative GPA of less than 0.5 above the minimum required and may be at risk of not graduating. Orange County Public Schools has the following policies in place to assist students in meeting the required grade point average.

- \* Grade Forgiveness which permits students to repeat a course in which they receive a grade of "D" or "F". The new grade earned replaces the previous grade in calculating the student's cumulative GPA.
- \* Summer school is offered for students who need to repeat required courses in which a "D" or "F" has been received.
- \* Credit reduction permits students who fail a full-year course but pass one semester to be awarded a half-credit for the semester passed. Students are allowed to repeat the semester failed during summer school.
- \* Alternate programs are available for high school students to make up credits.
